Sentence

1. What is a Sentence ?

Ans: A sentence is a group of words that makes a complete sense.

Example: i) The boy is going to School.

ii) My father is a Teacher.

2. Kinds of Sentences : i) Assertive Sentence
ii) Interrogative Sentence

* Assertive Sentence : A Sentence that makes a statement is called an assertive sentence.

Example : i) Ram is a good boy.

ii) I am not going to School.

* Interrogative Sentence: A sentence that asks a question is called an interrogative sentence.

Example : i) What is your name ?

ii) Are you a student ?

Proper Noun Common Noun

1. What is a Noun ?

Ans.: A Noun is the name of a person, animal, place or thing.

Example: Ram, Cow, India, Table, Milk, Book, etc.

2. Kinds of Noun : i) Proper Noun
ii) Common Noun

* Proper Noun :- A proper Noun is the name of a particular person, animal, place or thing.

Example : Ram, India, Ranchi, Ganga, Monday etc.

* Common Noun :- A Common Noun is a name given in common to every person, animal, place or thing of the same class or kind.

Example : Boy, Girl, Cat, Bird, River, Mountain etc.
