1. What is a Sentence ?

Ans.: A Sentence is a group of words put together in a certain order giving complete sense.

2. Kinds of Sentences :-

- i) Assertive Sentence :- A Sentence that make a statement is called an assertive sentence.
- ii) Interrogative Sentence :- A Sentence that asks a question is called an interrogative sentence.
- iii) Imperative Sentence:- A Sentence that expresses an order, a request or a piece of advice is called an imperative sentence.
- iv) Optative Sentence :- A Sentence that expresses some curse, blessing, prayer or wish is called an optative sentence.
- v) Exclamatory Sentence :- A Sentence that expresses some sudden or strong feeling of the mind is called an exclamatory sentence.

1. What is a Noun ?

Ans.: A Noun is the name of a person, animal, place, thing feeling or idea.

2. Kinds of the Noun :-

- i) Proper Noun :- A Proper Noun is the name of a particular person, animal, place or thing.
- ii) Common Noun :- A Common Noun is a name given in common to every person, animal, place, or thing of the same class or kind.
- iii) Collective Noun :- A Collective Noun is the name of a number of persons or thing take together and spoken of as one whole.
- iv) Material Noun:-A Material Noun is the name of a material substance.
- v) Abstract Noun:-An Abstract Noun is the name of some quality, state, feeling or idea that we can only think of or feel but cannot see or touch.
